As Director of the Office of Revenue and Tax Analysis in the Michigan Department of Treasury, Jay's responsibilities include forecasting economic activity, estimating and tracking State Government revenues, estimating the potential fiscal impact of proposed tax legislation, and evaluating tax policy issues. Jay advises the State Treasurer on economic and revenue issues and is responsible for the Administration's economic and revenue forecasts.

Prior to joining the Treasury Department in September 2009, Jay was the Senior Economist for the Michigan Senate Fiscal Agency, a position he held for over 18 years.

Prior to joining the Senate Fiscal Agency, Jay spent 1985 – 1990 in Washington, D.C., where he worked for the National Association of State Budget Officers and Price Waterhouse. Before going to Washington, D.C., in 1985, Jay spent 12 years as an economist with the Michigan Department of Management and Budget.

Jay received B.A. and M.A. degrees in Economics from Michigan State University.
